Since 2015, she has championed Integrated Reporting (IR) implementation across organisations and conducted training and engagement programmes on IR locally and internationally on sustainability, governance, risk and control, and financial reporting.

Her professional credentials include Certified Internal Auditor, Certified Public Accountant, Chartered Global Management Accountant, Certified Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) Analyst, and Certified Risk Management and Assurance qualification. She is a member of the Malaysian Institute of Accountants (MIA), Malaysian Institute of Certified Public Accountants (MICPA), Chartered Institute of Management Accountants (CIMA), Institute of Internal Auditors (IIA) Malaysia and Institute of Corporate Directors Malaysia (ICDM). holds a PhD in Accounting from the University of Birmingham, United Kingdom, and a Bachelor of Accounting from the International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM).
