Since 2019, the partnership has evolved into a popular offering for Bank Islam Credit-i and Debit-i cardholders, who enjoy 20% savings on ERL tickets, making airport travel and daily travel more accessible and seamless.

ERL, through its flagship KLIA Ekspres service, provides a premium high-speed rail link connecting Kuala Lumpur and KLIA, offering fast, direct, and hassle-free airport transfers. The collaboration has driven significant momentum, with card spending at ERL increasing 63% in 2024 and 36% in 2025, while transaction volume grew 75% and 31%, respectively, over the same period.

Bank Islam Chief Business Officer – Retail Banking, Mizan Masram, said, “Beyond business growth, this collaboration supports a more seamless and cashless travel experience for the public. By integrating banking services with transportation, Bank Islam continues to play a role in making journeys more convenient and rewarding. We want every journey to deliver extra value to our customers. Through this collaboration, we encourage customers to keep using their Bank Islam cards with ERL and enjoy the savings and rewards along the way.”

Building on this strong momentum, Bank Islam anticipates continued growth from its partnership with ERL, with total transaction value projected to rise by a further 10% by the end of 2026.
